During the construction of this new cell, a seam of bedrock has been encountered which must be removed to ensure availability of landfilling area. Removal of this bedrock by mechanical means has not proven successful. Appropriate measures have now been taken to engage a licensed blasting company to remove the rock under strict industry guidelines.</p>
