Vice President Report	<p>Report on Bunya Old School Reserve</p> <p>As you may know our Grant application through the Gambling Community Benefit Fund has been successful and we are very appreciative of all the help from Cameron Stanley, Arana Leagues Club who researched the grant and helped with the application for plus the Pine Rivers Catchment Association who were our auspice, for without them we could not have even applied for the grant.</p> <p>Also many thanks to Cr Matt Constance, Tim Mander MP and Samford Historical Society who were referees for the Grant. Also to Brian Battersby who is always there to help us. All of these people played their part in our success and I would like to thank them for their generous support.</p> <p>We received \$9350.00 from the grant and this will pay for the Archaeological Report and Management plan required by the MBRC before we can look at constructing the replica Lunch Shelter Shed with memorabilia, for which will also require another grant, this time hopefully from MBRC.</p> <p>For this next stage we hope to have support from our residents and interested families of past students with labour and or some donations.
